Commissioned Services 2020-21

<u>Sexual Health</u>

Essex Sexual Health Service (ESHS) continues to have a contract with HLP Ltd to manage sexual health services in both Essex and Thurrock up until March 2022. This consists of provision of emergency contraception to women aged 19 and under, and the provision of chlamydia treatment via PGD.

Of the 123 pharmacies that have a signed contract to provide the sexual health service, only 36 have actively provided EHC or chlamydia consultations or issued products.

During 2020/21, a total of 278 consultations took place, 3 for chlamydia and 249 for EHC in Essex and 26 consultations in Thurrock.

50 Community Pharmacies from the 123 signed up have distributed 521 condoms via the service using a smartphone app Ec-Card, 386 in Essex and 135 in Thurrock.

Stop smoking services

The Essex Lifestyles service continues to have a contract with HLP Ltd to manage the stop smoking service in Essex pharmacies, this will run up until March 2022.

In view of Covid-19 pandemic during the last year, community pharmacies have adapted and raised to the challenge of finding alternative ways to still support people wishing to stop smoking, without being able to use CO monitors nor consultation rooms, stop smoking advisors have still managed to assist over 1000 to successfully quit smoking.

HLPartnership Ltd ran an incentive scheme during October month and several pharmacy teams accessed the lunchtime webinars. Free medication for clients setting quit dates during the months campaign. Enhanced quit payment of \pounds 90 and \pounds 10 staff vouchers for each sign up that continued into week 2 – on the provision that someone from the pharmacy attended 2 lunchtime webinar sessions.

It was our best STOPTOBER ever with 650 quit dates set in one month and with 40 successful quits recorded. It was an impressive campaign and one for all to feel proud of when nationally, the stop smoking service has been hard to access

Another successful incentive HLPartnership co-ordinated started as a New Year scheme, but ended up running up until the end of March 2021.

A total of 79 pharmacies benefited from this incentive scheme. £1,650.00 was spent on the training bursary, where pharmacy team members completed online training courses, including the NCSCT Core Knowledge Assessment, Mental Health and Pregnancy courses.

A further 584 \pm 10 gift vouchers where also distributed to pharmacies because smokers set a quit date between January and March 2021 and had at least 1 follow up session.

Well done to everyone involved in such a successful incentive.

During the last financial year a total of 1237 people successfully quitted smoking through the support of Essex community pharmacies.

During the earlier part of the 2021, pharmacies that actively promote and support the stop smoking service received posters and leaflets, with the theme of "roadway out of smoking"

The leaflets were designed to be included into prescription bags and to reach out to a wide audience for those that may want to quit smoking, i.e., family members or friends that may not have attended the pharmacy but may see the leaflet in the household.

The idea behind the posters was to link with the government "roadmap out of

Covid-19". Posters will continue to be distributed as and when the Government lift restrictions.



HLPartnership would like to pass our sincere thanks onto Lisa Lovell who has continued to support and guidance stop smoking pharmacy providers. Lisa created a What's App group during the year that has proved very valuable for stop smoking teams, whether sharing information between each other, assisting with monitoring and providing excellent support to Advisors.

Thanks also to Rashmi Pattani for her support with assisting with all the payments for the stop smoking and sexual health service. Rashmi also produces the accounts for HLPartnership Limited and Association in readiness for our accoutants, Fisher Michael.

Other locally commissioned services

Thurrock Council Occupation Health "Flu vaccination service



This year the flu vaccination service did continue, however due to the covid-19 pandemic the numbers of council staff vaccinated were far lower than in previous years. 91 staff members were vaccinated by a local community pharmacy.

Thurrock and Basildon and Brentwood CCG warfarin service

The warfarin service continued in the same format again during 2020-21 within south west Essex, the numbers were slightly lower than last year, but covid-19 has contributed to this.

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Healthy Living Partnership Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" including the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Turnover

Turnover represents invoiced sales of services and membership fees received. The company is not VAT registered.

Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

Significant judgements and estimates

No judgements or estimations have been applied in the preparation of the financial statements.

Debtors

Short term debtors are measured at transaction price, less any impairment.

Creditors

Short term creditors are measured at the transaction price.
