








ESSEX LOCAL AUTHORITY EVENT FOOTPRINT 24-26 MAY 2024














ICB EVENT FOOTPRINT 24-26 MAY 2024

WHAT TO EXPECT

- 120 Elite female athletes racing at an average speed of 25mph
- Escort by police motorcycles, race officials, team support cars and race medical services
- Changes to the routes used in 2023
- Emergency services take absolute priority
- Parking suspended along the entire route & bus times altered

IMPACT

- Extended local road closures at start and finish venues to set-up event infrastructure
- Temporary road closures along the race route for approximately 20 minutes

ADULT SOCIAL CARE PLANNING

- Road closure information
- Vehicle crossing points
- Local Access Plans
- Filter to a small number of packages that need a specific plan:
 - Plan in detail with the event organisers to generate specific plans for those visits that are most impacted by the event and are unable to be adapted due to client needs
 - A bespoke plan, which is agreed by the care provider and the event organiser
 - Plans are logged and then monitored on the day of the event
- Use contact numbers for the event day on Sunday if access issues arise








ONLINE EVENT MAP & VEHICLE CROSSING POINTS
